READ 1 Samuel 30:1-6

BACKGROUND

CONSIDER THIS

As people assume more responsibility, leaders can expend more energy in other areas, enhancing their own sphere of influence and bringing additional knowledge and skills back to the group to be distributed once again among the group members.
