
FIVE WAYS WE GIVE AND RECEIVE LOVE

BACKGROUND

The five love languages are:

Words of Affirmation: A simple statement such as, "You look great in that suit!" is sometimes all a person needs to hear to feel loved.

Quality Time: This is about focusing all your energy on the other person. Quality conversation and quality activities are a very important part of quality time.

Receiving Gifts: If you speak this love language, you are likely to treasure any gift as an expression of love and devotion.

Acts of Service: As Jesus demonstrated when he washed the feet of His disciples, doing humble chores can be a very powerful expression of love and devotion. It can mean stepping out of the stereotypes.

Physical Touch: Many people feel the most loved when they receive physical contact. For a spouse, this can make or break the relationship.
